# Bollock Camera Act 2021

## 2021 CHAPTER 1

An act to issue servicemen of His Majesty's Police with cameras attached to their bollocks to serve in investigations [11<sup>th</sup> January 2021]

**B**E IT ENACTED by the King's ruling, with the advice and consent of the Privy Council, in this present government assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

### (1) **Bollock Camera Act**

- (1) A bollock-cam (ball-cam) is defined as a bollock-mounted camera used to record surroundings. HMP is the acronym for His Majesty's Police.
- (2) This Act contains Provisions for the implementation of photographic optical equipment to be worn within the parameters of one's lower torso intersectional area.
- (3) It shall be a mandatory requirement that all active and on duty HMP officers wear bollock-mounted cameras in order to:
  1. Record interactions with the public.
  2. Act as evidence in a trial.
  3. Provide safety for the officers as well as the general public.
  4. Remain undetected when undercover.
- (4) It shall be a mandatory requirement that all active and on-duty HIM officers have dash cameras in their vehicles.
- (5) If the previously aforementioned cameras are not used and or used incorrectly by a HMP officer then they will be suspended without pay while an investigation is undertaken which could lead to their dismissal from the service.
