

Mutual Recognition Treaty

Through the mutual agreement of the State of Gradonia and the Kingdom of Ikonian this treaty of mutual recognition is formed. This document seals the legitimacy and jurisdiction of the two agreeing states. This document opens free negotiation and all other relations to be legitimately formed.

Terms

I.

It shall be established that, in this treaty, the sovereignty and independence of the State of Gradonia and the Kingdom of Ikonian shall not be violated, infringed, disconnected, in the name of improving relations.

1.

The signing of the Treaty of Mutual Recognition between the State of Gradonia and the Kingdom of Ikonian, shall formally recognize the sovereignty and independence of both nations until stated otherwise or a form of dissolution of either state.

i.

In this document, it shall be established that the relations acknowledged by both parties is unbinding until dissolution of a nation, state, territory, or passage of opposing legislature is passed within a national house of representatives, and that the establishment of these connections be based on human rights.

2.

Through this recognition document of diplomacy, it shall be established that both nations remain separate, equal, and independent, as nations with regards to their legislature and affairs, that the document establishes relations between only nations that sign this treaty.

II.

Both nations acknowledge the relationship to be built on cooperation and peace between each nation, and that the citizens of both nations respect and accept the sovereignty, laws, and conventions of the other.

III.

This treaty shall formally come into effect one day following the signing and ratification of the document by either nation's independent national legislature, or alternate representative bodies, and the heads of state.
